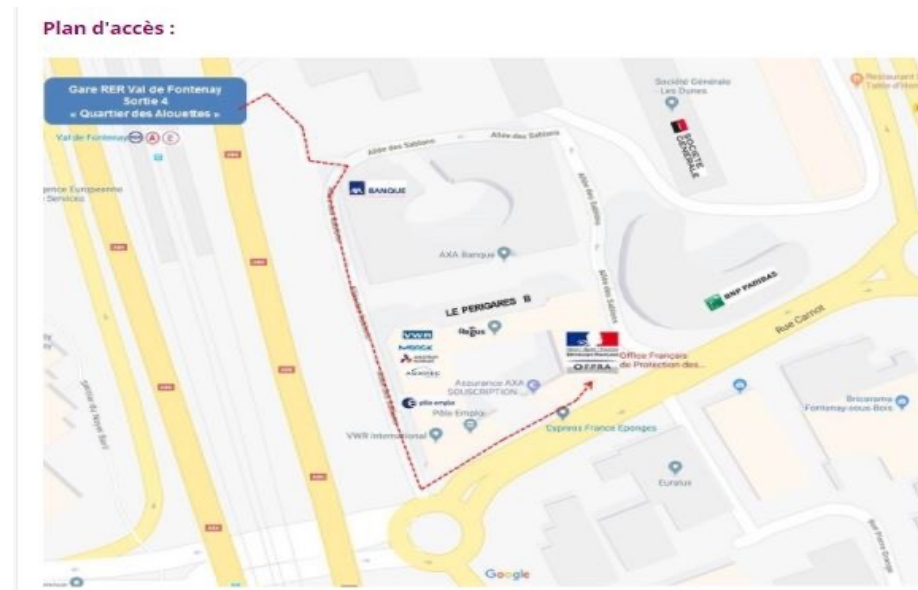


## Comment aller de Paris Gare de Lyon à l' OFPRA ?

Adresse de l'OFPPA : 201 rue Carnot 94136 Fontenay-sous-Bois

Transports en commun : RER ligne A direction Marne la Vallée – station Val de Fontenay – sortie 4 quartier des alouettes



## Utiliser le RER A

- When you arrive Gare de Lyon, you would have to look for the entrance to RER A, I don't know at which station hall you will arrive. Though, you can access RER A from any hall. RER A runs underground. You should look for signes such as shown next
- Once you reach RER A entrance, you have to proceed through an access gate, such as shown next. You must choose an access gate with a green colour (entrance only), with access terminal on your right. The terminal is fitted with a small slot where to insert your RER A ticket. Insert your ticket, then collect the ticket to open the gate. Keep your ticket, you will need it to exit at Val de Fontenay via the same process.
- Once within the RER station, please be aware there are different RER lines (A, D, etc.) running there. You should go to RER A line, direction Marne la Vallée or Chessy. You will have to go downstairs again. Proceed to the correct train platform.
- On each platform, there are screens showing the train directions. Not all trains go to Val de Fontenay. You must make sure you board the correct train by watching the screens on the platform (see next). Board a train that is announced to stop in Val de Fontenay.
- Step out of the train at Val de Fontenay. You need your RER A ticket to exit the station. Once there, walk to OFPRA (see map attached)
- You'll do the same to return from Val de Fontenay to Gare de Lyon. Enter the station, put your ticket in the terminal, chose direction Paris (all trains go to Paris then) and step out at Gare de Lyon.
